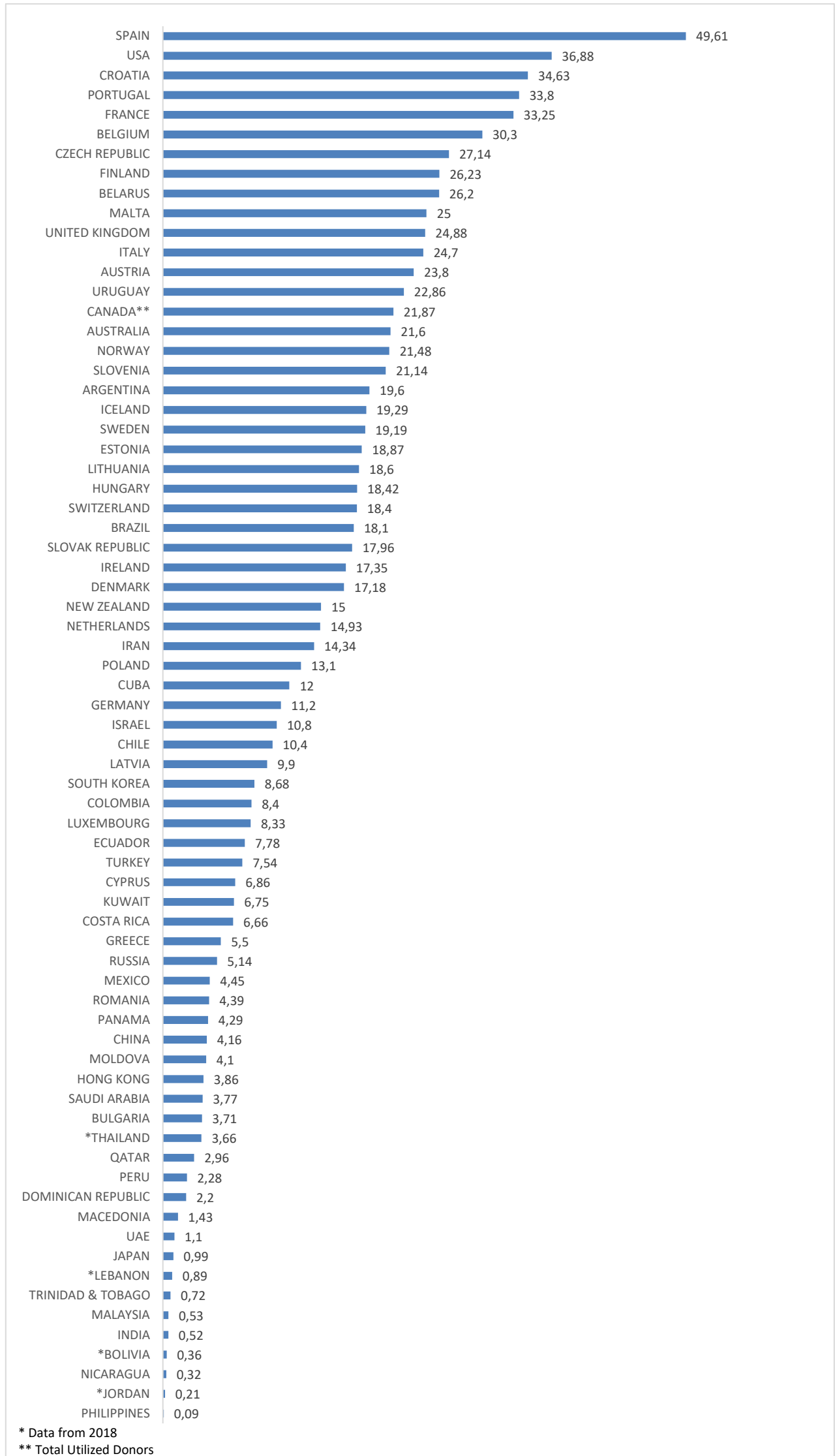
On behalf of the **IRODaT** staff, we are glad to present the 2019 preliminary numbers in organ donation and transplantation.

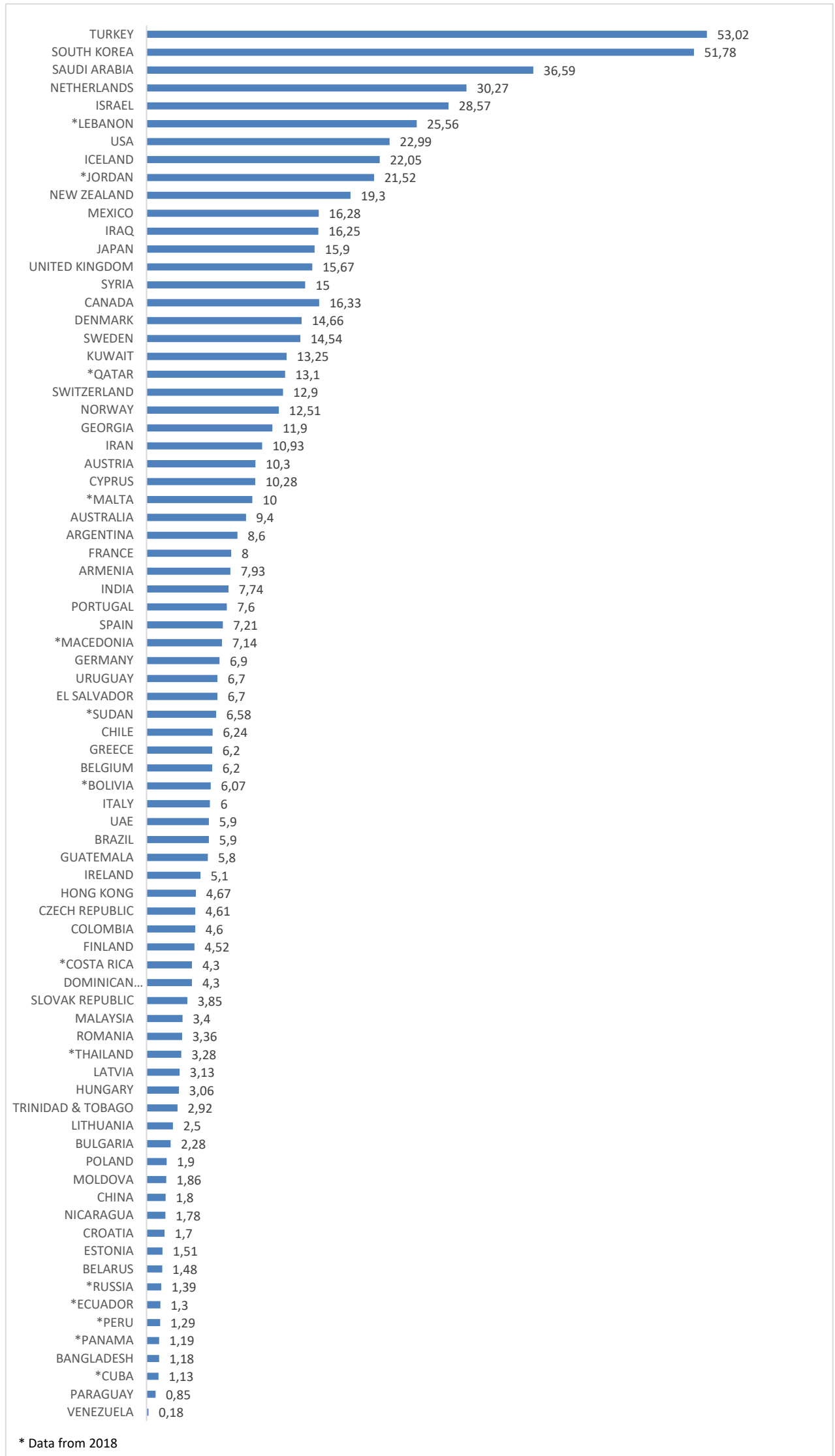
The mission of **IRODaT** is to support the healthcare professionals, transplant specialist, researchers and general community to have access to verified and validated information.

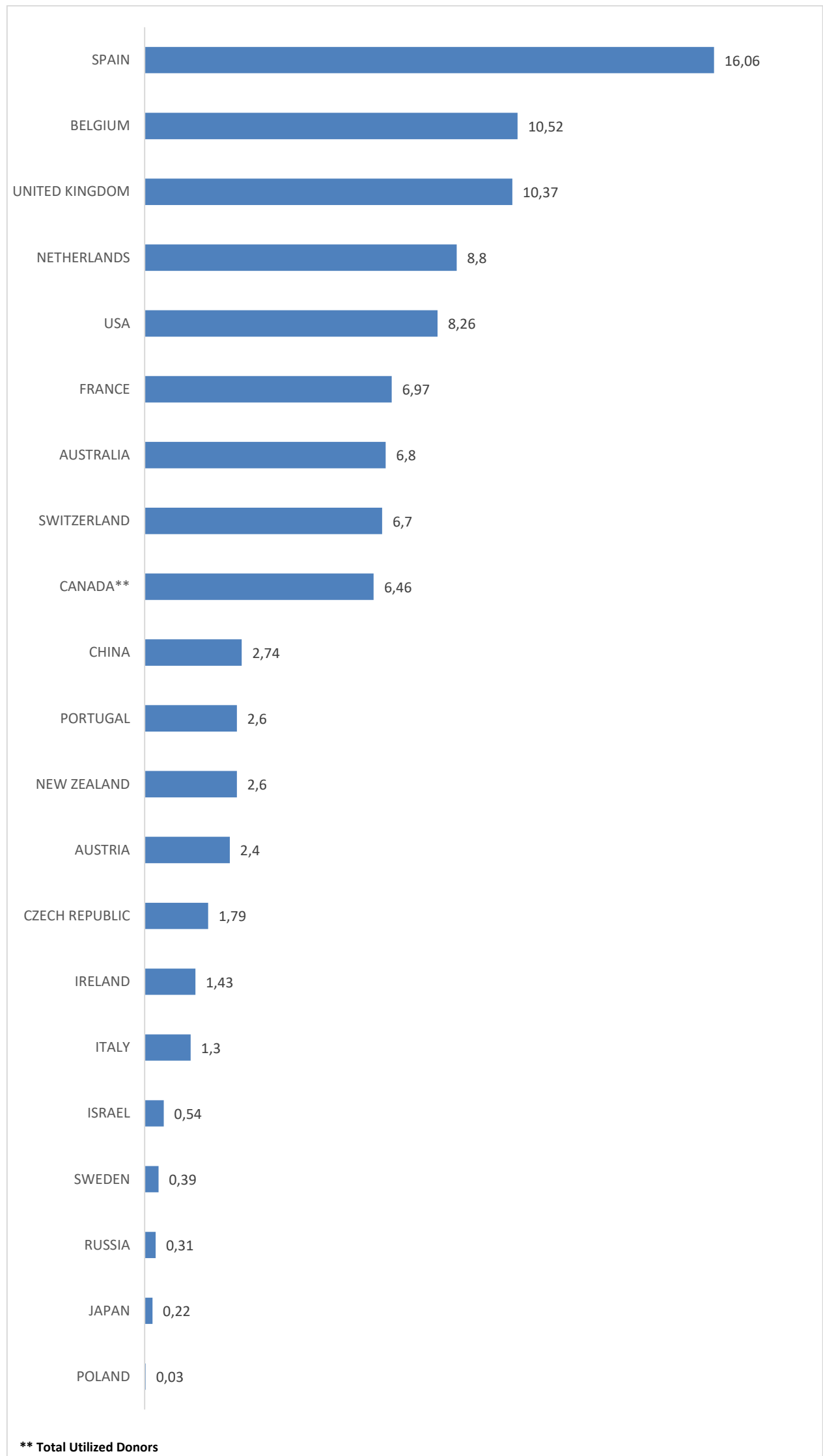

2. TRANSPLANTATION ACTIVITY

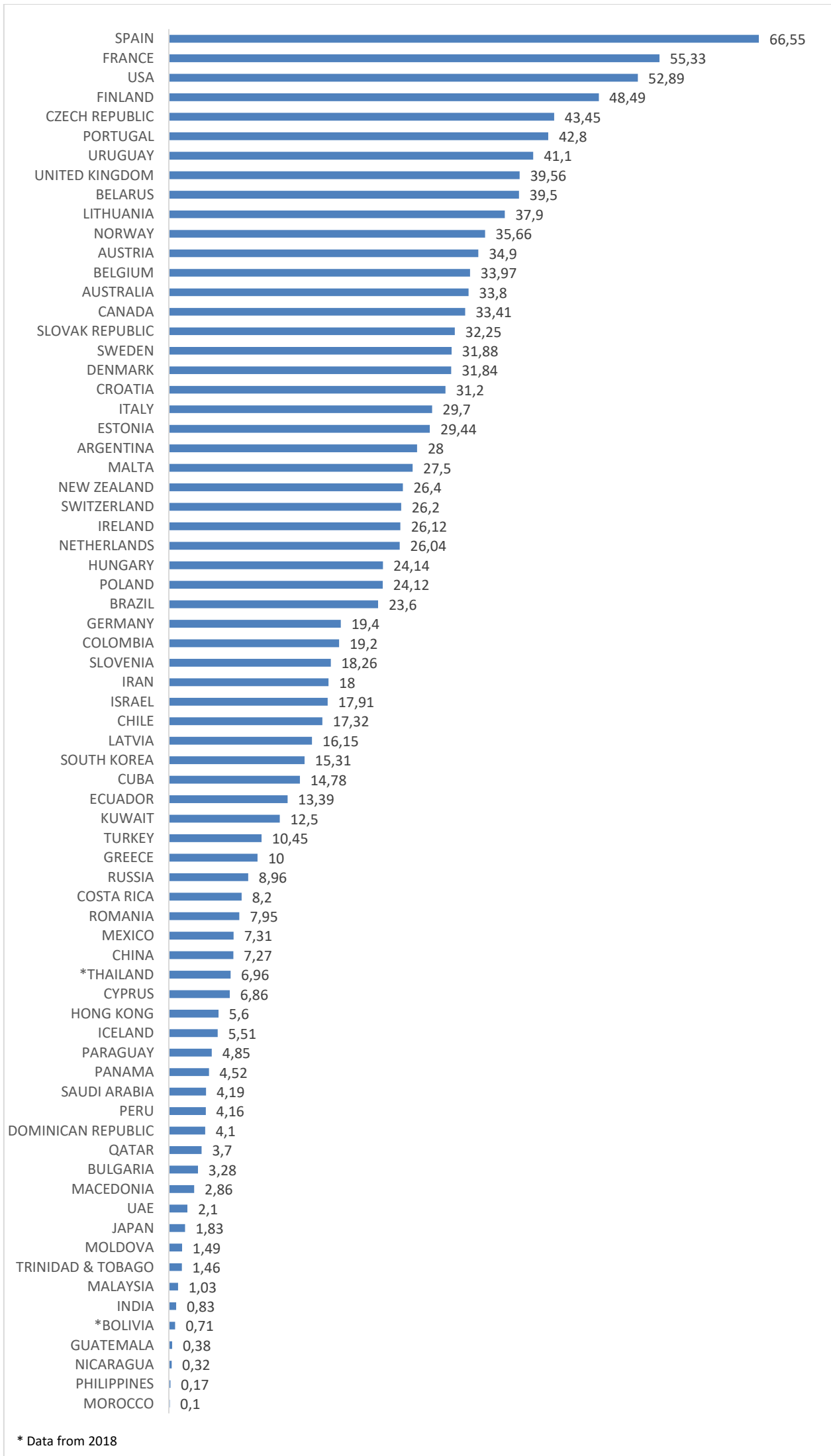

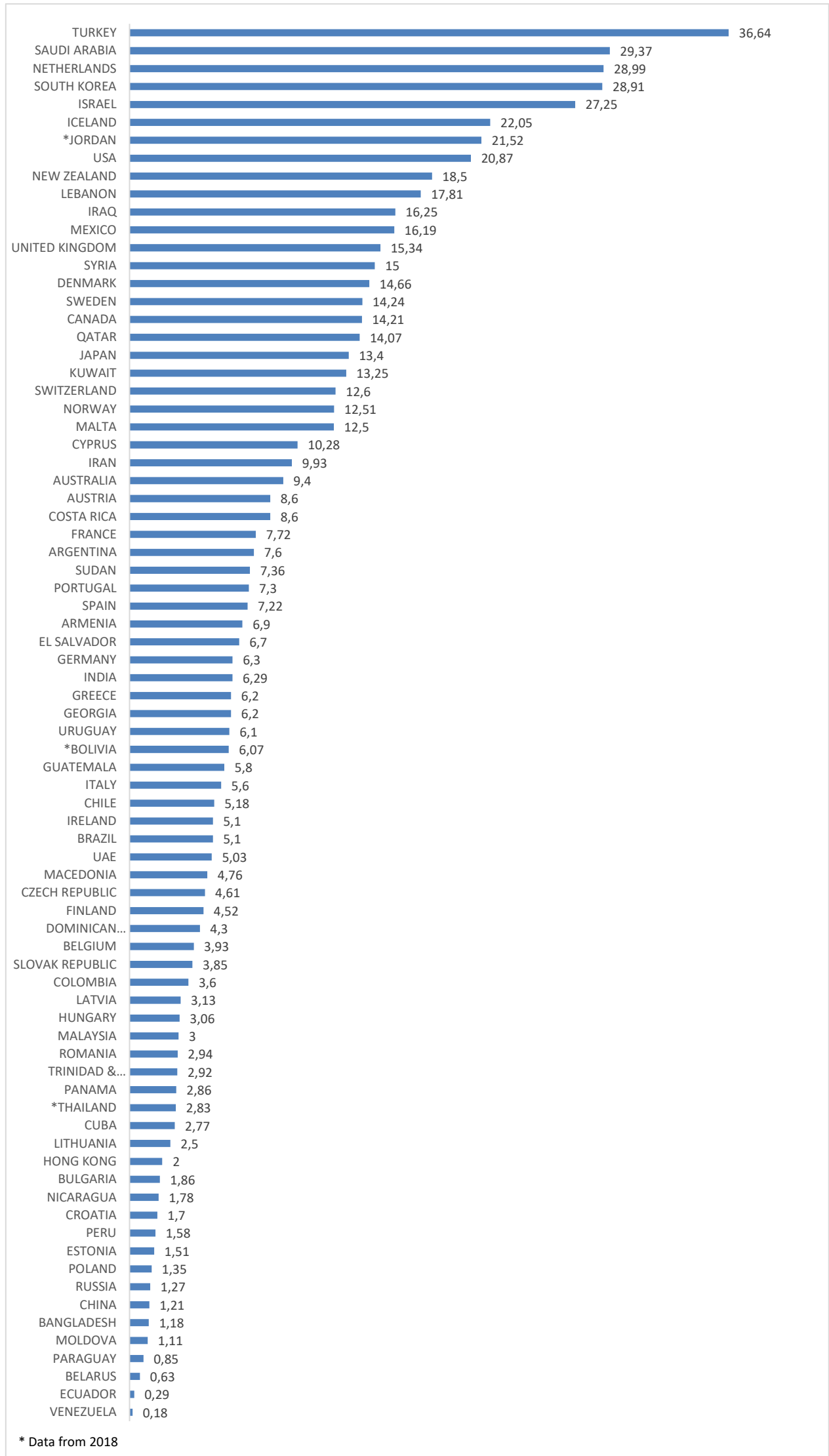
The case of kidney and liver transplant are divided into two figures, one for transplant from deceased donors and the other for transplant from living donors.

All graphs are represented in pmp, and the figures regarding transplant from deceased donors' numbers had included all combinations.

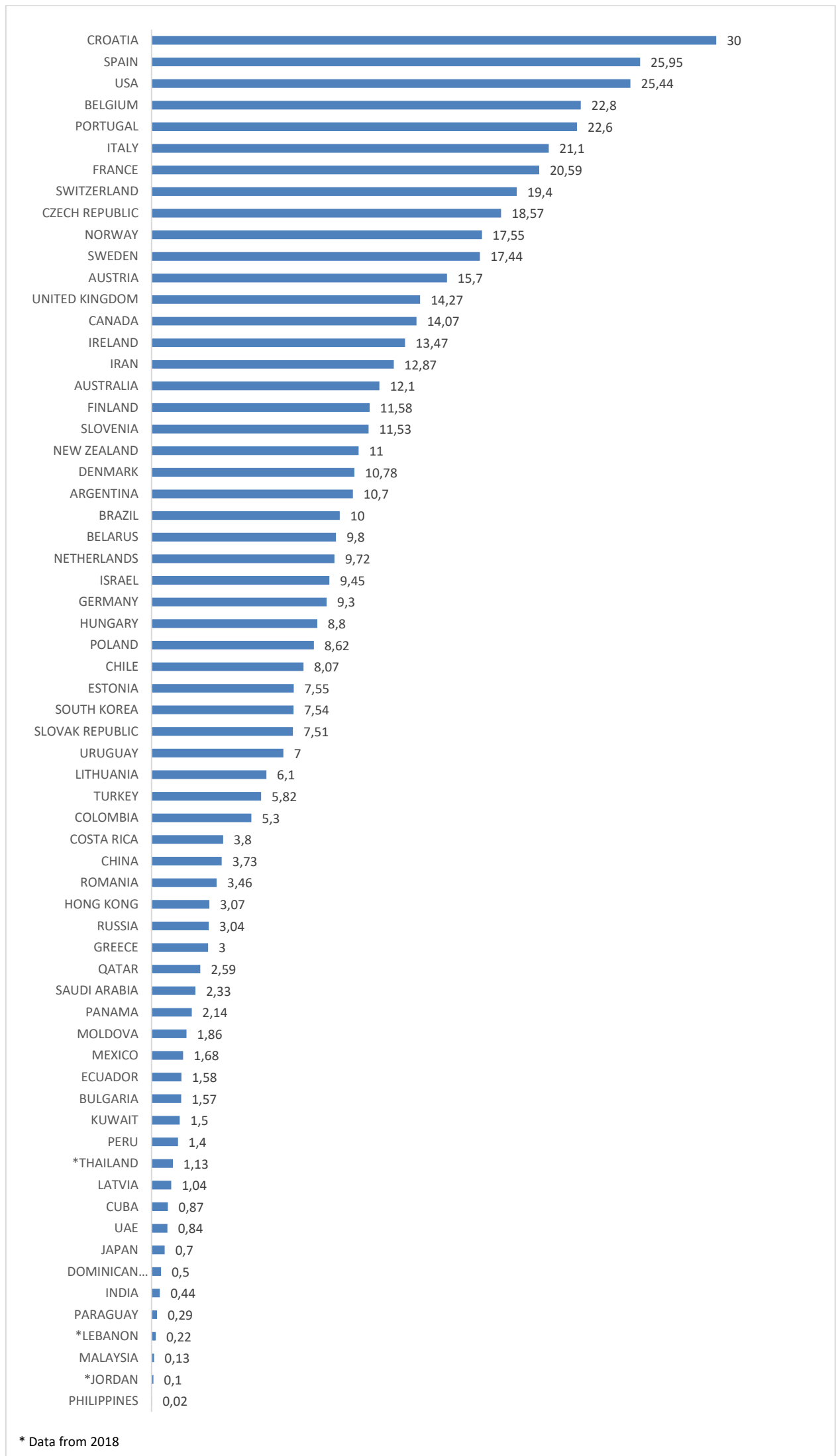

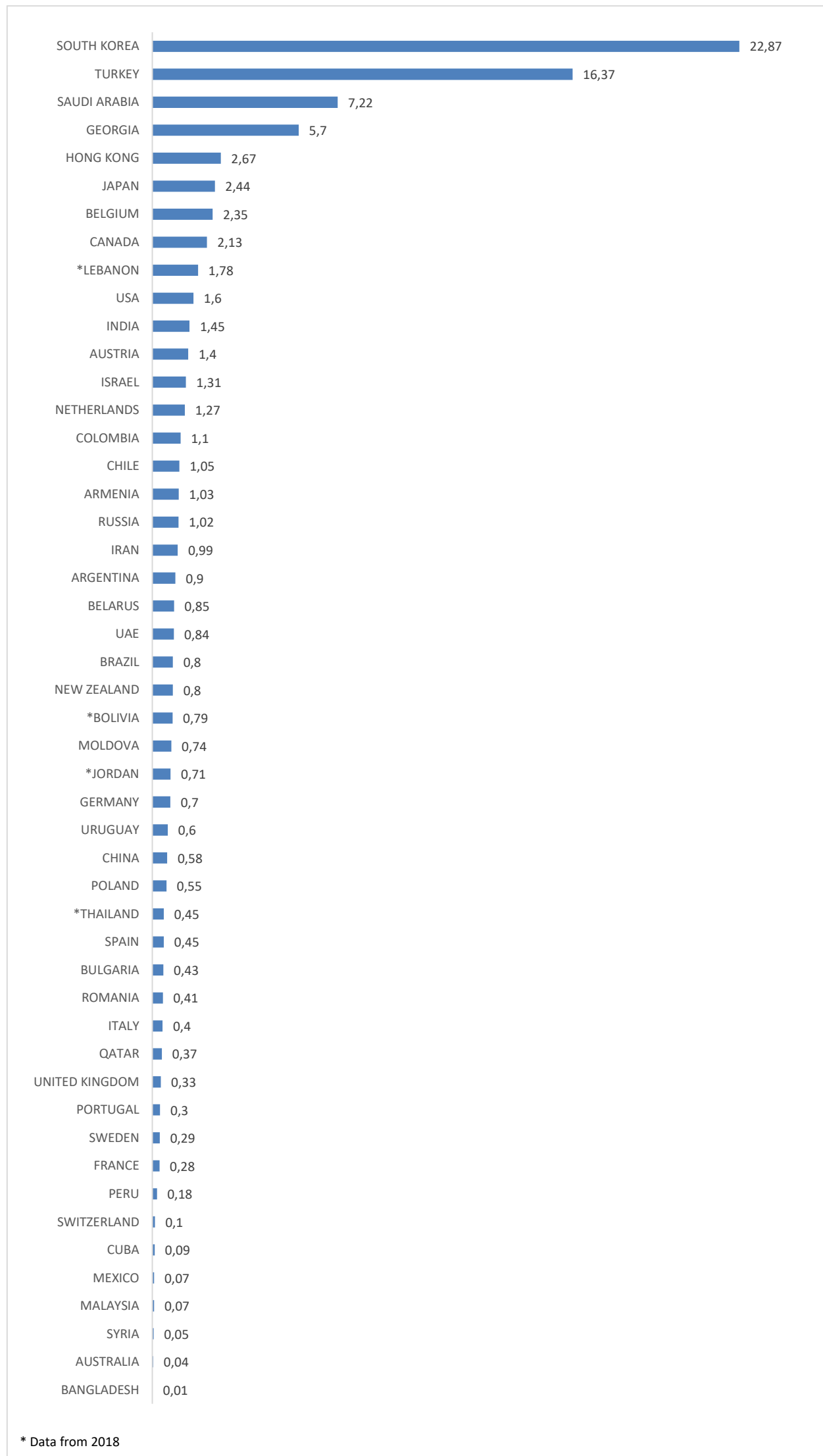
**WORLDWIDE KIDNEY TRANSPLANT FROM DECEASED DONORS RATE 2019

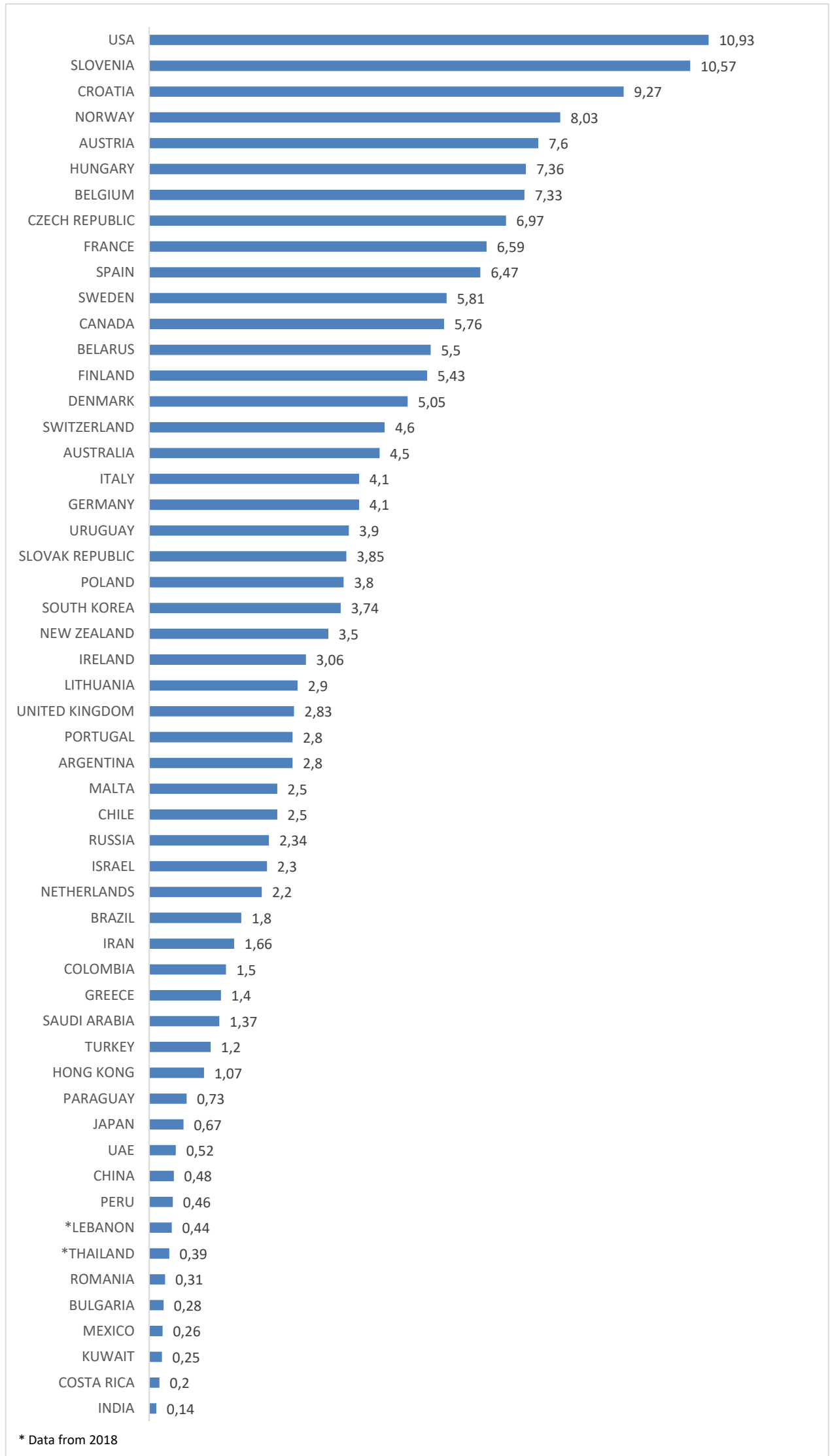


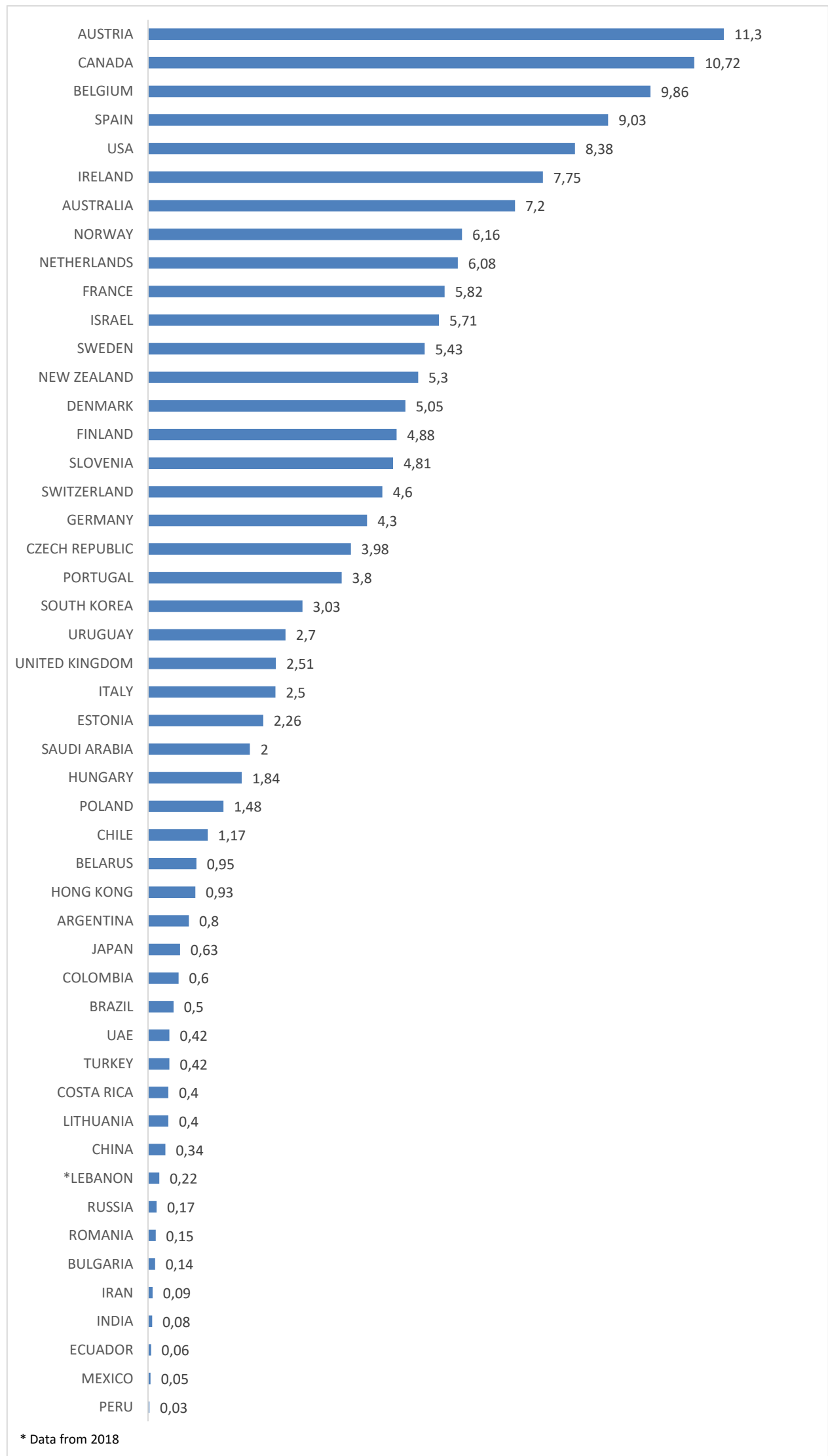
WORLDWIDE KIDNEY TRANSPLANT FROM LIVING DONORS RATE 2019 (pmp)

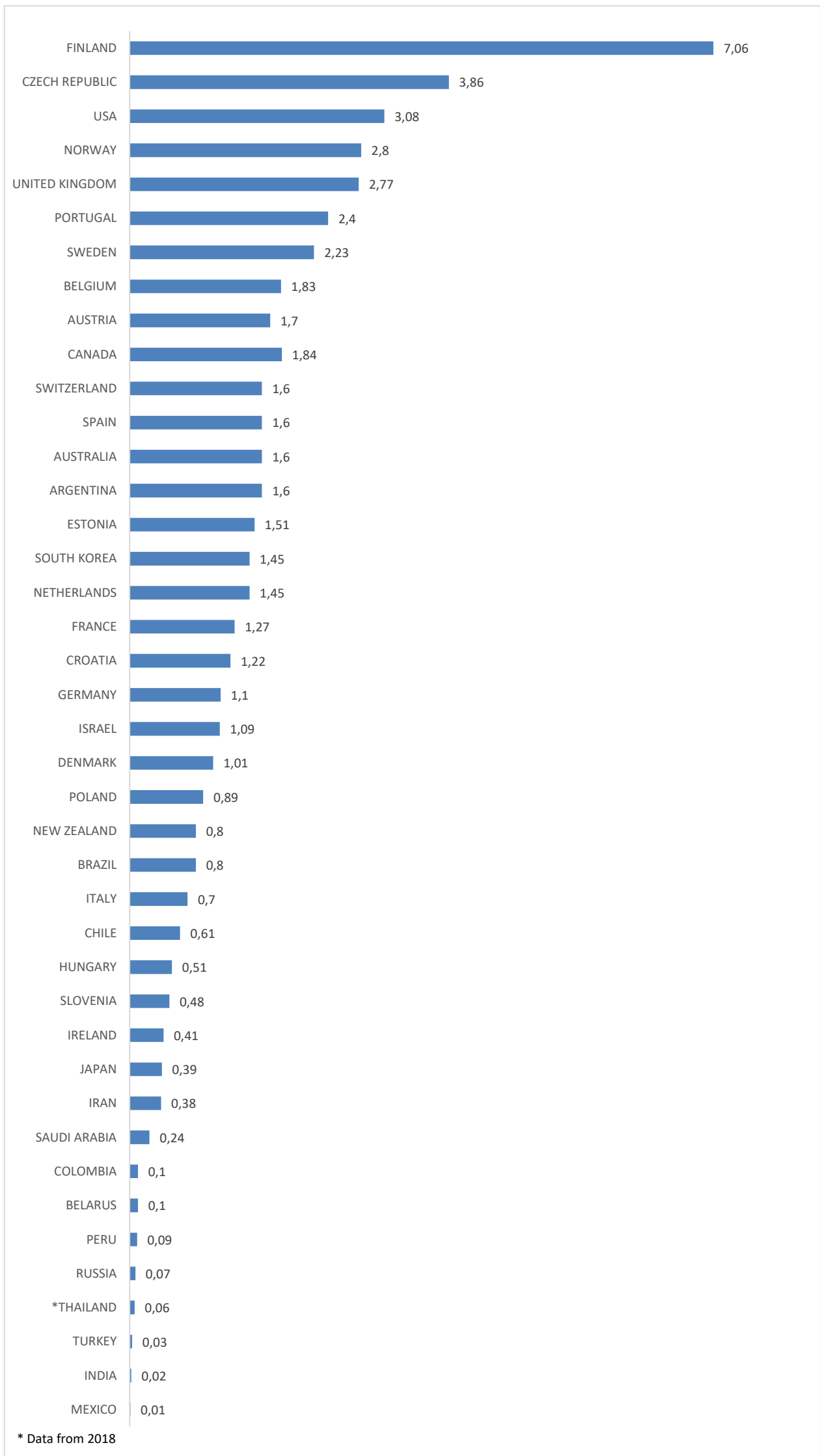
WORLDWIDE LIVER TRANSPLANT FROM DECEASED DONORS RATE 2019 (pmp)

3. DECEASED ORGAN DONATION RATE PER REGION

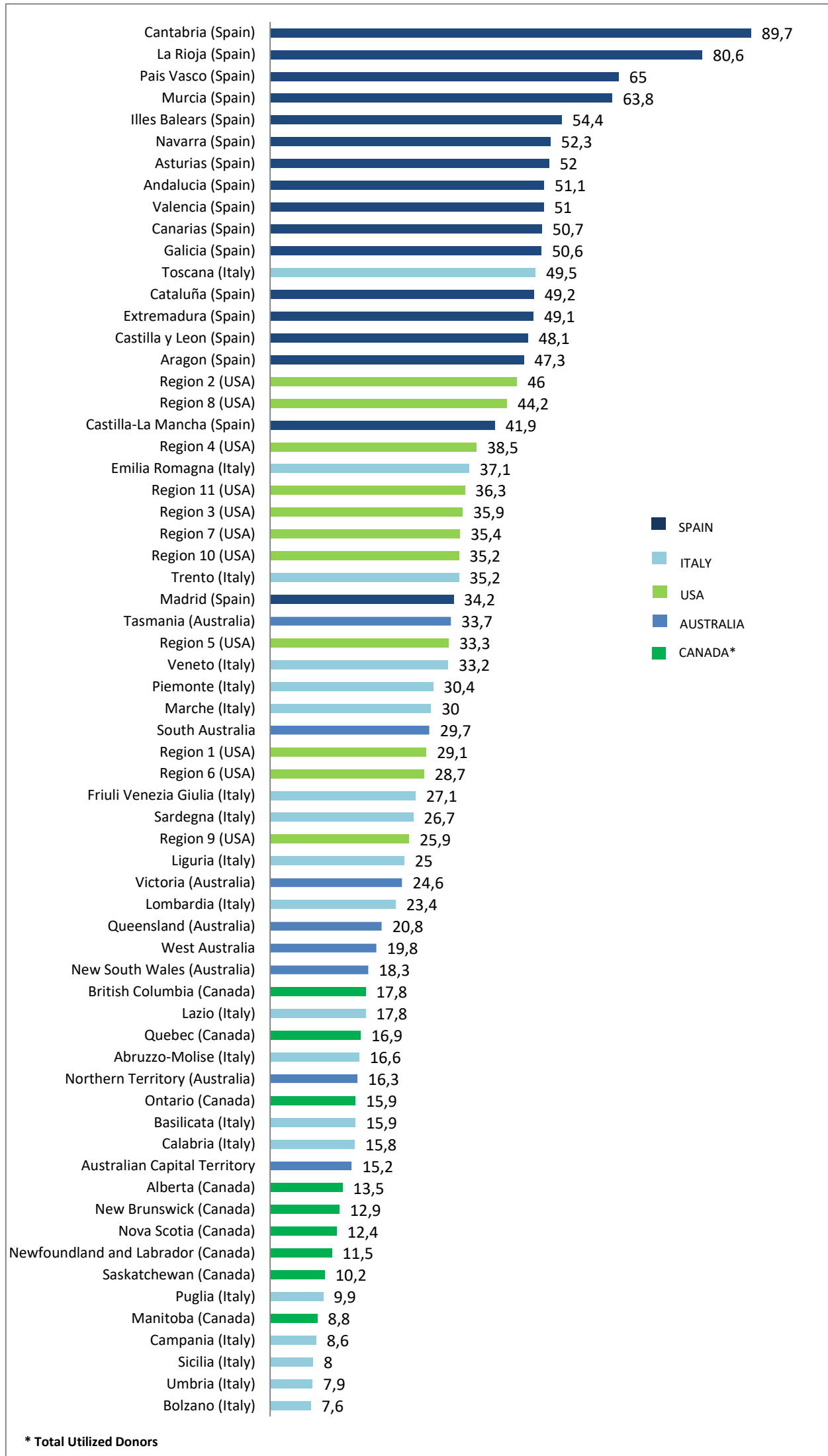
IRODaT is glad to present a new type of data report including deceased organ donation activity at regional level by country.
